### Saturday Game Rotation

Stableford
Two Low Net

### Saturday Men's Club Scoring Procedure:

#### Stableford:

- Determine each players handicap.
  - "Dot" the card appropriately for each players handicap.
  - Record the players gross and net score for each hole played.
  - Points are awarded for each player as follows:
    - 1 point – Net Par
    - 2 points – Net Birdie
    - 3 points – Net Eagle
    - 4 points – Net Double Eagle
  - Total the points for all players and divide by the number of players.
- Sign, Attest and Date Card

#### Two Low Net:

- Determine each players handicap.
- "Dot" the card appropriately for each players handicap.
- Record the players gross and net score for each hole played.
- Total on the bottom row of the card the total of the two-low-net scores used
- Total the two-low-net score for the team.
- Par for two-low net is always 126.
- SHOW TEAM SCORE AS TOTAL MINUS WHATEVER PAR IS FOR THAT GAME - e.g. 120-126 = -6
- Sign, Attest and Date Card

• NOTE: If playing with 3 players, you will need to rotate players by hole so that one player's score may be used twice each hole. Start the rotation by using the highest handicap player for hole one, mid-handicap person for hole two and the lowest handicap person for hole 3. Repeat this procedure for the remaining holes.

- On the scorecard add the "BLIND" score as 4<sup>TH</sup> player and enter the score of the player whose score is used twice for that hole (as stated above) whether or not you decide to use the duplicate score on that hole.
